



Prayers for the Dying

For a Departing Soul

When a sick person is known to be dying, relatives and friends should gather around the sick bed in the home or in hospital, and say the following prayers. If a priest is present he will lead the prayers, if not, a relative or friend should do this. Before beginning the prayers the dying person, room and others present are sprinkled with holy water and a crucifix placed in the hands of the person dying. (See image on back.)

The body should then be decently laid out, with lighted candles near. A small crucifix should be placed upon the breast between the hands, or else let the hands themselves be folded one upon another, in the form of a cross. The body is sprinkled with holy water, and from then until the time of burial, all present should pray for the repose of the departed soul.

The Last Agony

When the soul is about to depart from the body, then those gathered around the bedside, should, more than ever, pray earnestly for the dying person. The Holy Name of Jesus should be constantly invoked, and such ejaculations as the following, repeated in the dying person's ear:

Into Thy hands, O Lord, I commend my spirit.

O Lord Jesus Christ, receive my spirit.

Holy Mary, pray for me.

O Mary, mother of grace, mother of mercy, do thou protect me from the enemy, and receive me at

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(her) as he (she) craves, with heartfelt confession, the remission of all his (her) sins. Renew within him (her), O most loving Father, whatsoever hath been corrupted through human frailty, or violated through the deceit of the devil; and associate him (her) as a member redeemed to the unity of the body of Thy Church. Have pity, Lord, on his (her) groanings; have pity on his (her) tears; and admit him (her), who has no hope save in Thy mercy, to the sacrament of Thy reconciliation. Through Christ our Lord.
